

# REVOLUTION SERIES Protocol for Clinic + Shows under Covid-19

If you have been exposed to coronavirus, please help us stay safe, and stay home.

A signed COVID waiver is required. Masks should be worn for all unmounted exhibitors inside the show buildings including the barn. Please practice 6 feet social distancing guidelines when on the show grounds. The most current CDC guidelines will be followed; monitor our Facebook group for current show information.

Trainers and exhibitors are responsible for tracking temperatures. Anyone feeling unwell, or with a temperature should stay home.

#### **REVOLUTION STAFF PRECAUTIONS:**

Temperature will be taken of all employees and volunteers daily. Masks will be worn by all Revolution Series staff and volunteers while inside the show buildings and barn.

Revolution Series Staff will be monitoring and reminding trainers and exhibitors about social distancing guidelines.

#### Stay at home.

If you have been exposed or feel unwell.



# Barns stabled separately.

Each barn will be stabled in their own aisle.



#### Check your temperature.

Monitor your temprature every day at the show.



#### Limited spectators.

Exhibitors are encouraged to limit spectators.

Spectators will need to bring a mask.



#### Wash your hands.

Bathrooms will be sanitized every 30 minutes. Hand sanitizing stations will also be available.

Please keep a distance of 6 feet from others on show grounds, and when entering the show office.



## Schooling, Show Office, Ribbons, Food Service.

- Number of horses will be limited in the schooling ring. Jumps to be disinfected with spray after use.
- A maximum of four people in the office at a time with social distancing rules followed.
- Exhibitors are encouraged to fill out a credit card form or leave a check with their Trainer. Trainers will process their check out.
- Ribbons/prizes to be picked up by Trainers at the end of the show day.

#75 Best Turned Out  Class Fee: \$5 To be donated to the Year End Sportsmanship award.  #1 Lead Line  Class Fee: \$20	Open to exhibitors showing in the Revolution Series Invitational classes only. The winner will be selected as an exceptionally groomed horse and rider that shows pride in their presentation. Attention to detail, clean and properly fitted tack, show clothes and appointments representative of your discipline will be judged at a walk and line up. #### HORSE SHOW INFORMATION

#### **ATTIRE:**

Proper show attire is strongly encouraged for all classes. Collared shirts are permitted for leadline through the Beginner division. Half chaps with paddock boots are permitted in all classes.

All Riders are required to wear USEF approved head gear. Braiding is not required, but highly recommended for Finals and Invitational classes.

#### **CLASSES:**

- \*USEF rules apply if not covered by Revolution Series.
- \*Management reserves the right to cancel, split or combine classes.
- \*Entry into any Classic, Eq.Challenge, Derby or Mini Prix requires entry in at least one division. Minimum of 10 riders in \$500 Invitational Classics, 7 riders in the \$300/\$250 Invitational Classics.
- \*Ribbons will be offered for each class. Prizes offered to Champion and Reserve Champion riders with at least 3 riders. Entry in the entire division is required for Champion and Reserve Champion eligibility. Medals awarded in Equitation Challenges.
- \*Exhibitors are expected to be prompt for their classes. 2-minute gate call rule will be enforced and followed.
- \*Exhibitors are ALL expected to follow good sportsman like behavior

#### **STALLS:**

- \*Revolution Series suggests 4-5 shavings and a mat, OR 5-6 shavings without a mat.
- \*Stalls and shavings can be reserved online or by calling/texting Ashley 224-645-1744. Orders must be in one week prior to show.
- \*Stalls will be available after 12:30pm on Friday.
- \*Stall requests with completed entries 2 weeks prior to show date will receive the early entry stall rate of \$70. Entries received after the deadline will be charged the regular \$85 stall rate.

# YEAR END AWARDS QUALIFICATIONS

Riders participating in the Revolution Series shows from November – September will accumulate points from each show. The Rider with the most points at the end of the year will receive special ribbons 1st. 6th. Prizes and ribbons will be awarded at our Series Finale. Riders must show in at least 2 Revolution Series shows of the qualifying year. The Division must have at least 3 riders accumulating points with attendance of more that 1 show, to qualify for a year end prize and/or ribbon. Ties will be broken by the rider who attended the most shows, and then by the rider with the most points over fences. For Intro Walk/Trot and Dressage divisions there will only be one class called back to Finals. Final class in each division at the Series Finals will be weighted 3x more. Equitation Challenges, Hunter Handy/Derby, Jumper Classic, Mini Prix/High Jump, 2' Hunter Classic, Mini Hunter Derby will be shown as Invitational Classics. No yearly points will be accrued for these classes since they are not divisions. Instead, riders will accumulate their points and the top scoring/placing riders will be invited into our Series Finals Invitational with increased prize money.

I understand and agree that by entering this Competition, I am subject to Revolution Series Rules, the Prize List, and local rules of the competition.

#### Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition to the following:

I AGREE that the "Revolution Series" and "Competition" as used above includes all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm").

I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Revolution Series and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Revolution Series or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Revolution Series or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Revolution Series and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition. I have read the Revolution Series Rules about protective equipment, including GR801 and, if applicable, EV114 and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Revolution Series strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. 
