## YEAR END AWARDS QUALIFICATIONS

Nominated riders participating in the Revolution Series shows from December – September will accumulate points from each show. The nominated riders with the most points at the end of the year will receive special ribbons 1<sup>st</sup>- 6<sup>th</sup>. Prizes and ribbons will be awarded at our Year End award party in November. The Division must have at least 3 riders accumulating points with attendance of more than 1 show to qualify for a year end prize and/or ribbon. Ties will be broken by the nominated rider who attended the most shows, and then by the nominated rider with the most points over fences. Final classes in each division at the Series Finals will be weighted 2x more. Equitation Challenges, Hunter Handy/Derby, Jumper Classic, Mini Prix/High Jump, 2' Hunter Classic, Mini Hunter Derby and Crossrail Classic will be shown as Invitational Classics. No yearly points will be accrued for these classes since they are not divisions. Instead, riders will accumulate their points and the top scoring/placing riders will be invited into our Series Finals Invitational with increased prize money.

Proper show attire is strongly encouraged for all classes. Collared shirts are permitted for leadline through the Beginner division. Half chaps with paddock boots are permitted in all classes. All Riders are required to wear USEF approved head gear. Braiding is not required, but highly recommended for Finals classes.

### **Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification**

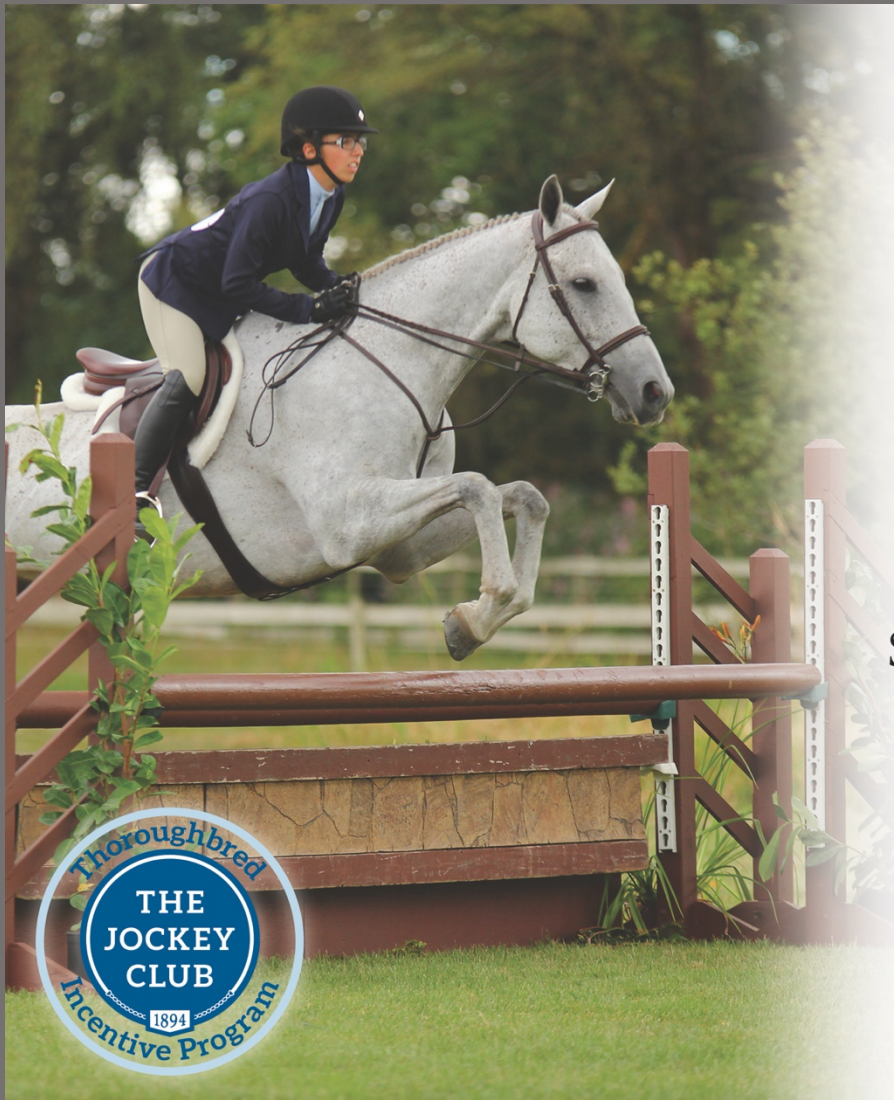
